### Finance Report

- Finance committee met and approved the \$1,866MM 2022 budget
- Received the draw from Foundation. Were challenged by them to understand the plan.
- Thanks for the 3 year budget and all the work that went into it.
- Expenses slightly higher than last year
- Benefits will remain the same
- Reinvest into ministry areas
- Motion to approve the 2022 balance budget as proposed in December by Suhr, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hackler.

- Intergenerational Stewardship Policy needs to be rectified
- Iris Key and Sten Johnson are interested in being members of the Finance Committee
- Motion to approve report by Suhr, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Albrecht. Voice approves

#### Governance

- A few revisions made to constitution and statutes
- Defined officers versus members
- Clarified responsibilities and authority
- Kirwan asked how we discern the line between property and operational authority
- Childes said we need to do more to put together a policy to provide the strategic direction by the operations to move forward if the committee chair has brought it to approval
- Childe moves to approve changes to the constitution, Hackler 2nds. Voice approves.
- Nowlin suggests we have clear cut lines in the statutes from Admin with reports. Who is the administrator of the Cathedral? Tim?
- Childe suggests Admin role deserves a sub section of statutes. Have Dean and Admin fill in the blanks and get back to council. We have been missing it for years. We should write it down.
- Childe moves to accept Statutes, Albrecht 2nds. Voice vote approves.
