Decision Process

Approved 10/16/2014

- 1. Proposal is brought to appropriate Committee/Commission, in a regularly scheduled meeting, or is presented by a member of the Committee/Commission. The Chair determines if a proposal should be considered.
- 2. Chair of a Committee/Commission may appoint a subcommittee to work on the proposal and get back to the Committee/Commission.
- 3. Subcommittee researches issues and prepares a recommendation to the Committee/Commission
- 4. Committee/Commission decisions should be made either with all meeting participants, including presenters and other interested non-members present **OR** among voting members only, at the Chair's discretion.
- Committee/Commission hears the report, discusses issues, decides if proposal is ready for consideration by the Council. If so, Chair notifies the Senior, Junior Warden and Treasurer.
- 6. Wardens and Treasurer decide whether another Committee/Commission should review the proposal before it comes to the Council.
- 7. For items that require funding, the Committee/Commission Chair shall forward the recommended proposal to the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee will conduct a fiscal review. The Finance Chair shall forward a summary of the fiscal review to the Council through the Wardens. The Committee/Commission Chair would provide technical/background support to the Council to assist with Council deliberations.

- 8. If the Wardens want another Committee or Commission to review the proposal, the Wardens and Chair of Committee/Commission notify the Chair of the Committee/Commission assigned to review the proposal. That Chair places the proposal on the agenda for the next meeting and shares the proposal with members in advance.
- 9. Following their review, the reviewing Committee/Chair sends the conclusion to the Senior Warden and Chair of the originating Committee/Commission.
- 10. Depending on the review, the proposal and recommendation either go back to the originating Committee/Commission for further work or it is placed on the agenda of the next Council Meeting for presentation and consideration.
- 11. The Council meets and votes to approve, disapprove the proposal or send it back to the originating Committee or Commission for further work.
